

## **Sheridan Township - Sample Ballot April 3, 2012**

You must choose which party you are voting in for presidential preference. If you are using the touch screen voting equipment once you choose your party you are given the list of candidates in that party and can choose one (or write in one). If you are using the paper plus scanner ballot you should choose a party first. If you choose Democratic any marks for a Republican will be ignored. The touch screen system prevents this mistake.

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Select the party primary in which you wish to participate. Then select one candidate from within that party. There are two races that are non-partisan. Your presidential preference has no impact on these races.

**PARTY PREFERENCE**

**YOU MUST EXPRESS YOUR PREFERENCE FOR EITHER THE REPUBLICAN OR DEMOCRATIC PARTY. YOU MAY VOTE IN ONLY ONE POLITICAL PARTY.**

To select the party of your choice, complete the arrow to the RIGHT of the party of your choice.

In the Presidential Preference Election, if you vote more than once, your vote will not be counted.

Express your preference for one of the persons whose name is printed on this ballot; or

Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party of your choice; or

Write in the name of another person to become the presidential candidate of the party of your choice .

To vote for the candidate of your choice, or for the uninstructed delegation, complete the arrow to the RIGHT of the candidate's name or to the RIGHT of "Uninstructed Delegation". To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and complete the arrow .
