Notice to Voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials.)

IMPORTANT: It is recommended to use an official ballot marking pen available at your polling place or a #2 pencil.

Instructions to Voters



If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)



To vote for a name on the ballot, complete the arrow next to the name like this .


To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in," and complete the arrow next to the name like this .

**RESOLUTION TO EXCEED
REVENUE CAP
COMMENCING WITH THE
2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR BY
AN AMOUNT OF \$650,000**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Prairie Farm Public School District, Barron and Dunn Counties, Wisconsin, that the final school district budget shall include an amount not to exceed \$650,000 in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes each year for a period of five years on a nonrecurring basis, beginning with the 2018-19 school year and ending with the 2022-23 school year, for the purpose of paying District operation, staffing and maintenance costs.

QUESTION

Shall the School Board of the Prairie Farm Public School District be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2018-19 school year through the 2022-23 school year on a nonrecurring basis by an amount not to exceed \$650,000 each year for the purpose of paying District operation, staffing and maintenance costs as provided in the foregoing resolution?
